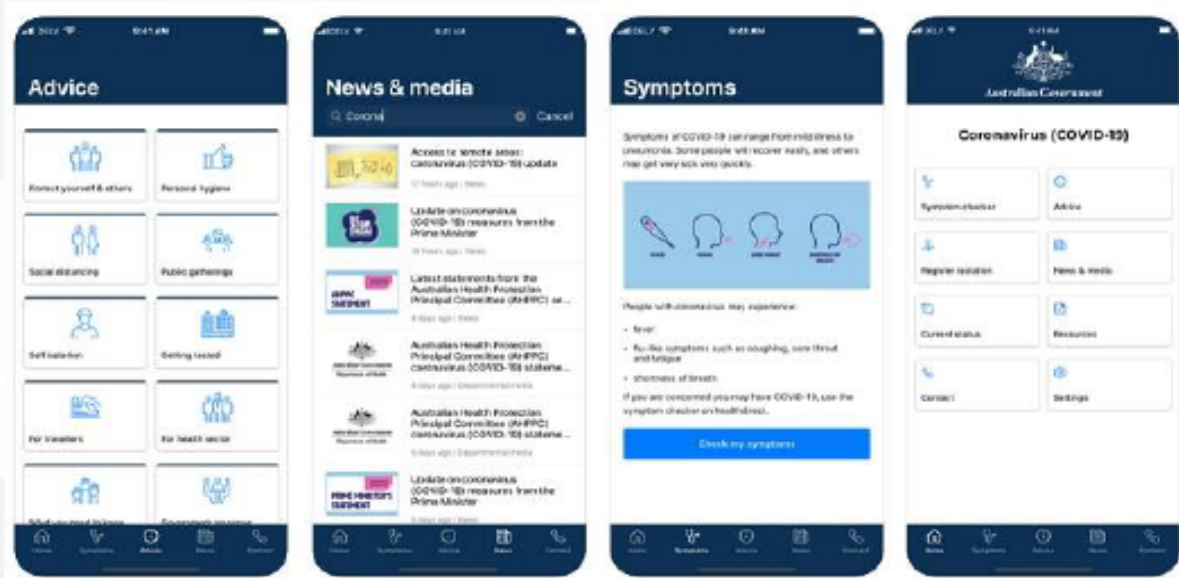




# Coronavirus (COVID-19) Australia App

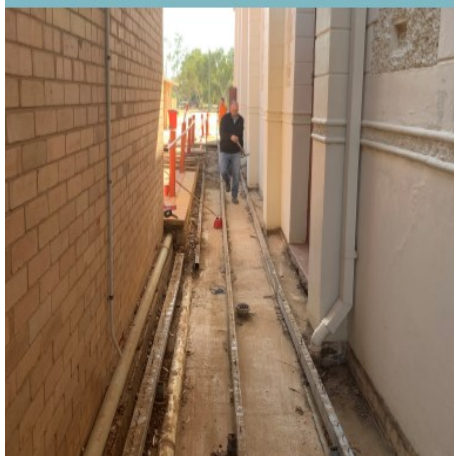

# April Works Report

The Shire of Tammin would like to advise that the new concrete floodway on Chappell Wheeldon has been installed. We have encountered some delay due to the COVID 19 restrictions, as the situation is easing, the gravel re-sheet work will resume mid-May on Chappell Wheeldon Rd, Cubbine Rd and Wyola North Rd.

We would like to thank you for your patience.

The Shire crew is currently working on the installation of subsoil drainage at the Town Hall; this will help keeping the groundwater away from the building area and preserve our Town Hall for the future. The work is anticipated to be finished before the end of May.

The façade of the Town Hall has been repointed, loose bricks have been reinstated and it is now looking very good. In a couple weeks, works will start to install a disabled toilet room within the Town Hall.

An undercover area will also be installed at the pavilion between the existing building and the transportable ablution block at the rear of the building.

Works and services are still looking for some existing or potential gravel pits, we will be in contact with land owners to identify and excavate some test pits in areas where gravel could be sourced for the maintenance of the road network. This gravel would be used within a radius of 10km of the pit to improve conditions of existing unsealed roads.

## 2020 NRM COMMUNITY STEWARDSHIP GRANTS NOW OPEN

The 2020 Community Stewardship Grants are now open for community-based projects that help conserve, restore, rehabilitate or enhance a local natural area, conserve WA's biodiversity and maintain or build the capability of NRM community groups across the State.

Local Member Mia Davies MLA has encouraged **local groups** to get their applications ready, and invited them to contact her office for support or assistance as they prepare their submissions.

"There are two categories available, small grants valued between \$1,000 to \$35,000, and large grants intended for more strategic, complex projects between the value of \$35,000 and \$450,000," Ms Davies said.
