Are you keeping your dog confined within your own premises?

Did you know that the fence type, height and construction should be suited to contain the breed, age, size, and physical condition of the dog?

Maintaining your fences and ensuring that the gates at the property are closed when your furry friend is home are just some of the responsibilities of owning and caring for a dog.

Also dog and cat registrations are coming up!

Be sure to renew your dog and cat registration by October 31st.

This is a legal requirement under the 1995 Dog ACT.



The Shire crew are now working on maintenance works throughout the Shire , maintenance grading and repairs are underway. Contractors have been engaged to help with the maintenance grading on Yorkrakine West Rd, Wyola North and South Rd, Parrawilla Rd, Franklin Rd, RPF Rd, Quatermaine Rd, Quinn Rodgers Rd & Kitto Rogers Rd. Some repairs have been executed hence the slower progress. By the end of the month the crew will move to the North West quadrant of the Shire. A collapsing Culvert has been replaced on the York Tammin Rd and the road is now safe to use.

Following our wet winter, the front dam is full and the secondary dam is at 50% capacity, this will help with the watering of the oval during the summer months.

An application to clear vegetation at the intersection of Ralston Rd and Gardner Reserve Rd is underway; this will clear the line of sight for oncoming traffic for the school bus and other vehicles.

The administrative process for the Tammin Southern Link is now with the Department of Planning for approval, it is anticipated that the works will start in the New Year and completion before Christmas 2022.

A portion of Bungulla North Rd between kilometre 7 and 9 will be reconstructed in early 2022 as well as the floodway section on Tammin Wyalkatchem rd between kilometre 15.3 and 15.8.

Gravel resheet will take place on Dixon Rd between kilometre 4 and 6, on Nelson Rd for the first 2 kilometres and on Rabbit Proof Fence for the whole length (5.5km), these projects will be undertaken in March April 2022.

ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIAL IS TO BE REMOVED FROM THE WHOLE OF THE LAND EXCEPT LIVING TREE, SHRUBS AND PLANTS. THE REMAINING VEGETATION IS TO BE MAINTAINED TO A HEIGHTOF NO GREATER THAN 7.5CM

CALL 000 TO REPORT A FIRE!

BUSHFIRES ACT

FUEL REDUCTION AND FIRE-BREAK REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, you are hereby

required on or before the 1st day of November 2021 to construct fire breaks and/or clear your property of flammable material in accordance with the following, and thereafter to maintain fire breaks up to and including the 1st day of April 2022.

Townsite:

Land Area less than 2048m2

All hazardous material is to be removed from the whole of the land except living trees, shrubs and plants. The remaining vegetation is to be maintained to a height of no greater than 7.5cm.

Townsite:

Land Area greater than 2048m2

All land over 2048m² is to comply with the requirements of rural land.

This is to be maintained for the duration of the restricted and prohibited burning periods.

Tammin Rural Land

All land is required to have a bare mineral earth fire break not less than 3 meters in width immediately inside all external boundaries of said land.

All land surrounding erected buildings is required to be cleared of all flammable material by way of burning, slashing or mowing, and maintained to a height not greater than 75mm.
