- The footpaths of Tammin are having a facelift this year with Shield's Street almost complete and works being done on Ridley Street.
- The Tammin Primary School have had a new crossover put in as well as footpaths around the school grounds ready just in time for Term 2.
- Asphalt repairs have been completed near the Post Office to improve the intersection heading into town.
- New Asphalt was laid at the entry to the CBH site leading towards the new section of road joining onto the Southern Link Bypass, increasing the road rating to RAV 7.3.


CHECK OUT COUNCIL FACILITIES
