CEO UPDATE<u>Fire Season Information</u>

As we head into the summer season, it's important to stay informed about our fire regulations. We're currently in the restricted burning period, which runs until 31st October 2023. During this time, you'll need a burning permit for any controlled burns.

Starting 1st November 2023, we enter the prohibited burning period, and this means absolutely NO fires until 14th February 2024. These measures are in place to ensure our community's safety and prevent bushfire risks during the dry months ahead. Please keep these dates in mind and be aware of fire safety in our Shire. Your cooperation is much appreciated.

This is also a reminder to make sure your fire breaks and hazard reduction activities have been carried out in accordance with the Shire of Tammin's Firebreak Order 23.24.
