Bitumen Patching Truck

Other roads which will be receiving attention include Bungulla North Road and Tammin Wyalkatchem Road. The truck will be in Tammin for up to three weeks. We would like the truck to get to as many roads as possible; however cost is the limiting factor. Motorists are urged to take care when travelling on our sealed rural roads in May; observing warning signage and be prepared to stop as the truck may be stationary or travelling very slowly as it repairs potholes and the edges of the roads.
