#### **Fire Breaks**

The fire season is not far away. With the wetter winter this year, the grass (and potential fire hazard) is greater than the recent past years. For town blocks, now is the time to have that spring clean-up and for vacant block owners, to consider your options for the removal of the fire hazard.

In the past years, the Tammin Volunteer Fire Service has burnt a number of blocks. The Volunteers have indicated that they do not have the resources to be able to continue this service.

The Shire of Tammin's Firebreak Order required 3m firebreaks around the property boundary and around all buildings on the property by 1 November and to be maintained through to 1 April. Consideration is being given to the issue of Infringements for those property owners have failed to carry out these works. If you have an opinion on this issue, you are urged to contact your local Councillor.

Also, if you are interested in contracting for fire breaks or clearing town blocks, please contact the CEO.

#### **Audit Committee**

Anyone interested in serving on the Shire of Tammin's Audit Committee is asked to contact the CEO. The role of the Committee is to provide an independent oversight of the financial systems of the Shire of Tammin on behalf of Council. The Committee is required to meet once per year and to examine audit reports and management letters and advice received from the Shire of Tammin's Auditor and to ensure appropriate action and response is provided. Ivan Rogers and Donald Thomson have previously served on the Committee.

### **Zone Control Authorities (ZCAs)**

The enactment of the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act* has resulted in the wind-up of the Agricultural Zone Control Authorities (ZCAs) which provided an opportunity for involvement in landscape-based pest issues (mainly concerning invasive species, weeds and feral animals). In the past, Peter Ralston has represented Tammin farmers on this Authority.

Council has resolved to support an informal meeting of elected representatives, held annually, to discuss biosecurity threats, existing and potential (invasive species, weeds and feral animals) and provide advice to the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Council as an interim measure until a Recognised Biosecurity Group is established.

#### Interested In A Career In Medicine?

Financial assistance to medical students committing to a career in rural and regional medicine will continue with two perpetual scholarships administered by the University of Western Australia.

The new scholarships will replace those offered by the recently wound up Country Medical Foundation, and will be named the Country Medical Foundation Scholarship in recognition of the significant role played by the Foundation in fostering improved health care services in country Western Australia.

Two scholarships will be awarded annually to assist and encourage students in completing a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery at UWA who are experiencing financial hardship and who demonstrate a commitment to undertaking a career in rural or regional WA.
