Road Name Changes

Landgate has advised that by Ministerial Order, the road name Dunne Road has been changed to Dunn Road – correcting the spelling error which appears to have occurred some years ago. The Road is named after the Dunn family which farmed in the area back in the 1950s.

The road name Old Yorkrakine Road has also changed to Russell Street – after the Russell family which contributed much to our town over many years. This section of road was renamed when the Yorkrakine Road was realigned when the road house was constructed.
