Permission is readily granted provided the guidelines are followed. Additionally, if liquor is to be sold, then a Liquor License is required to be obtained from the Clerk of Courts.

General Electors Meeting

This years meeting is to be held on Tuesday 12 February 2008. The Annual Report for the financial year 2006/07 will be mailed out to all residents around 3 weeks before this date.

In addition to the statutory items (adoption of Annual Report, Financial Report, Auditors Report etc.) Council has determined that the future of TALEC and the Town Hall need to be discussed.

In relation to TALEC, a number of factors has seen the annual operating deficit to be costing between 10-15% of rate income. In relation to the Hall, in recent years ground water has caused immense problems to the building. The future of both of these major issues needs to be considered.
