Due to commitments by a number of Councillors, which would have left Council without a quorum, the August Council meeting has been deferred for a week to 23 August 2007. As this meeting will adopt a Budget for 2007/08, the deferral means another week before rate notices are issued!

Celebrations

From the record included in the Shire of Tammin's history book *Wheat, Wool and Wodjil*, the Meckering Road Board was established in 1895 and stretched from the Northam, Toodyay and York District boundaries eastward almost to Merredin. A Tammin representative joined the Meckering Road Board in 1904. The Kellerberrin Road Board was formed on 17 October 1908. The Meckering Road Board subsequently became the Cunderdin Road District on 3 November 1944.

On 18 June 1948 the Tammin Road District was gazetted with the first meeting of the Tammin Road Board being held on 9 August 1948.

This event is to be celebrated on it's 60th Anniversary next year. Council has determined the appropriate date being 9 August 2008 – 60 years after the Council's first meeting.

Details of the celebrations will be publicised as arrangements are firmed up.


Land Release
