## TAMMIN WASTE SITE RULES AND REGULATIONS

> **All visitors must stop at the site office on entry to the Waste Site**

> **Tip pass required** (No tip pass may incur a fee as per Tammin Shire Council fee and charges)

> **Separate your waste** - Load your ute/trailer so the waste is not intermingled, there are certain things that go in designated sections of the waste site.

*Separate Green - Household - Wood - Steel etc, this will make it easier to unload at the waste site.*

Loads that are intermingled may incur a fee.

*Car Boot - \$10 Unsorted waste*

*Single Axle Trailer - \$18 Unsorted Waste*

*Tandem axle trailer - \$30 Unsorted Waste*

> **Acceptable waste**

*Household waste*

*Household appliances—Certification of removal of CFC's by licensed contractor*

*Construction and Demolition Waste*

*Inert Material (Concrete, Sand, Rock)*

*Steel*

*Wood*

*Vegetable (Green) Waste*

*NON Hazardous - NON Infectious*

> **Unacceptable Waste**

*Household Appliances Containing Class 1 or 2 (CFC's/HCFC's), Refrigerators, Freezers, Air conditioners, Water Coolers.*

*Tyres, Oils, Paints and Solvents, Bio hazardous Waste, Hazardous Waste - Liquid Wastes.*

*NO WASTE OIL (as per the Tammin Shire's license for the waste site)*

> **Compulsory fees charged at the waste site**

*Commercial waste—\$45/tonne*

*Bulk rubbish (trucks) - \$40/m3*

*Car bodies—\$35*

*Truck/plant (including trailers, caravans) - \$200*

> **No Asbestos to be dumped without completing an Asbestos Form** - *(forms can be obtained from the Shire Administration office; prior notification is to be arranged before the asbestos is taken to the waste site to insure the asbestos waste can be safely disposed of).*

*Asbestos Waste fee (commercial) - \$150/m3*

*Asbestos Waste fee (residential less than 1m3) - \$100/m3*

Random Waste Screening is practiced at the site, we reserve the right to inspect any load, No Smoking, No Scavenging Allowed.

**NOTE: Unacceptable items will be refused at the site. Fines apply for any illegal dumping.**

## Council Civil Works

### Ralston Road (Roads to Recovery Project)

2 kilometre section of road to be reconstructed, widened and sealed to 7.2 meters wide. From the intersection of the Tammin York road 00km, the works will start at 6.5 km to 8.5km, narrow section.

Pre construction works are proposed to commence mid September, shoulder and drainage works, clearing debris.

There will be traffic management at the site, Some delays for road users will be encountered during these works.

### Tammin Wyalkatchem Road (Regional Roads Project)

1.8 kilometre section of road to be reconstructed, widened and sealed to 7.2 meters wide.

From the intersection of the Great Northern Highway 00km, the works will start at 2.6 km to 4.4 km, narrow section. (around Golf Links Road)

Pre construction works are proposed to commence late September, shoulder and drainage works, clearing debris.

There will be traffic management at the site, Some delays for road users will be encountered during these works.
