

	New Houses – Nottage Way	Underwood Road	Old Depot Site

Prohibited burning period until 14 February 2015	Council has agreed to purchase two 3 x 1 transportable houses from McGrath Homes to be sited on 3 and 5 Nottage Way. The project is being funded from Royalties for Regions (\$313,000) and Shire funds (\$120,000).	The Shire will soon be commencing the reconstruction of part of Underwood Road (between Packham and the Rail crossing). Access may be restricted for short periods of time during construction and seal works.	Due to a number of factors, including poor building condition, asbestos, ground contamination and being of no use, Council has agreed to consider the demolition and clearing of the Old Depot site next financial year. The preferred option is to clear the site, revegetate and leave as public open space.
Restricted burning period until 15 March 2015	It is anticipated the houses will be delivered to Tammin in May 2015.
