Shire Electrical Service

The Tammin Shire Council has agreed to discontinue with the Electrical Service at the end of the current financial year.

When the Electrical Service started in 2011 the aim of Council was to sponsor a new business in Town that would be able to carry on independently of the Shire after a period of time. As this is not possible Council has agreed that it is not appropriate to continue subsidising a business that is in competition with private contractors.

It is very unusual for a local government to employ an Electrician, with Tammin being the only known Shire in WA to do so. As a local government we are required to abide by numerous rules and regulations including not being able to own a private business.

It is acknowledged that the Shire Electrician and Apprentice have been good competent workers and the Shire has benefited from their employment in regards to the electrical maintenance of our buildings.

Expression of Interest - Connecting Biodiversity across the Wheatbelt of Western Australia

Free Seedlings, Fencing & Pest control in 2016

Landholders in the WA Wheatbelt now have the FINAL opportunity to expand native habitats on their properties through a coordinated revegetation, fencing and pest control project.

Native seedlings, fencing and monetary assistance for pest control will be offered to eligible landholders wishing to protect and restore existing vegetation, create wildlife corridors to connect fragmented remnants and control invasive pest animals in these ecologically important areas. Please note that the seedlings are bio-diverse and contain a variety of over-storey, mid-storey and under-storey species.

Criteria:

Your project must connect or expand an area of existing remnant vegetation.

Participants to carry out activities in the following Shires only: Beverley Bruce Rock, Cunderdin, Kellerberin, Koorda, Merredin, Mt Marshall, Nungarin, Quairading, Tammin, Trayning, Westonia, Yilgarn and York. Priority will be given to land managers that can implement all three components of the project: revegetation, fencing of existing remnant vegetation and control of pest animals.

You must be able to accept and plant seedlings during June/July 2016.

Landholders are responsible for the planting of seedlings, erection of fencing (within 1 year) and control of pest animals and must be prepared to maintain the site for the following 10 years.
