Chief Executive Officer – Shire of Tammin

Council has agreed to appoint Jenny Gemund as CEO for the month of September 2015 and has agreed to appoint Peter Naylor as CEO for the period 1 October to 31 December 2015.

The Cunderdin and Tammin Shire Councils remain committed to pursuing a shared CEO arrangement. The Cunderdin CEO is away on leave during September and both Councils have agreed for Tammin to appoint Peter until the end of December to allow time for the Resource Sharing Agreement and contract negotiations to be finalised. Jenny has been employed at the Shire for more than 5 years and is well known in the community.

Rates due date

To receive the 5% discount you have to pay the full rates amount before or on Thursday 10th September 2015. The first instalment is also due on 10 September 2015.

The Shire of Tammin has been a successful recipient of KidSport funding.

The State government through the Department of Sport and Recreation is a major supporter of KidSport in WA. KidSport enables Western Australian children to participate in community sport and recreation, no matter their financial circumstances. Eligible youth aged 5–18 years can apply for financial assistance to contribute towards club fees. The fees will go directly to the registered KidSport clubs through their participating local government. While the primary objective of KidSport is to ensure all Western Australian children can participate in sport and recreation clubs, its secondary objective is to engage these children and their families in the community.

When to nominate

Nominations open on Thursday 03/09/2015 and close at 4.00pm sharp on Thursday 10/09/2015.

Where to nominate

At Shire of Tammin office, 1 Donnan Street, Tammin WA 6409.

Nominations must be on a prescribed form that is available from the council office.

An \$80 nomination deposit is required as well as a profile of the candidate consisting of no more than 150 words. You can include a recent passport sized photo of the candidate's head or head and shoulders if you wish. If unable to personally attend to nominate, an authorised agent can do this on your behalf.
