8. Public Question Time

During Public Question Time, community members were invited to present their questions, all of which were addressed at the meeting to the extent possible. Where a question required further investigation, clarification, or follow-up beyond the information available at the meeting, the items have been noted below.

- Request from hockey club to look into additional lighting for hockey grounds as current football lighting does not reach and it makes it difficult training in winter.
- Can Council do something about an increase in trucks using local roads when entering from the south of town. Trucks are turning off York-Tammin Road at McLaren St as a "shortcut" to get onto the Great Eastern Highway heading West. It has been suggested we could erect "Local Traffic Only" Signage or look into changing the RAV ratings to prevent them.
- The school requested Council create a community Garden and provide a new swing set at the school. Council has money in the current budget for a community garden and requested community support in getting the garden started. For the swing set council indicated they would be willing to consider it as a community grant in the 2026/27 budget but we would require the school to have it cleared by the education department.
- A request was made to install signage with information/ history on historic locations around the shire.
