### Type

### Scope

Reports and updates from the TVJAPC will refer to the Council for guidance where required. Otherwise will be responsible for Tenancy Allocation of all units.

### Authority

Committee of Council in accordance with s5.9(2)(c) of the Local Government Act 1995 and Division 4

- 5.17. Limits on delegation of powers and duties to certain committees

    - c) to a committee referred to in section 5.9(2)(c), (d) or (e), any of the local government's powers or duties that are necessary or convenient for the proper management of
      - (i) the local government's property; or
      - (ii) an event in which the local government is involved.

other person means a person who is not a council member or an employee.

- (2) A committee is to comprise
  - (a) council members only; or
  - (b) council members and employees; or
  - (c) council members, employees and other persons; or
  - (d) council members and other persons; or
  - (e) employees and other persons; or
  - (f) other persons only.
