It's About Time for country people with diabetes to access telehealth

Country people newly diagnosed with diabetes might be able to start off on a better footing with support from a telehealth service.

Timely access to help for people with diabetes is the message for National Diabetes Week 2017, July 9–15, whose theme “It’s About Time” is about getting an early diagnosis and taking action to prevent complications from the disease.

People who don’t have access to a diabetes educator near their home can get advice they need by videoconferencing with the Diabetes Telehealth Service (DTS).

Run by Diabetes WA for the WA Country Health Service, the DTS is a free education and clinical support service for people living with diabetes in country WA.

Gary (surname withheld) from Southern Cross says consultations are a good reference point for him.

“I can bounce ideas off someone, and keep abreast of changes, new medications and ideas, and keep up with trends in diabetes treatments,” he said.

Diabetes WA credentialed diabetes educator Rebecca Flavel said there could be serious repercussions for people who didn’t act quickly to changes habits after diagnosis.

“People with diabetes are up to four times more likely to have a heart attack or stroke and diabetes is one of the leading causes of kidney disease,” she said.

It is estimated that more than 123,000 Western Australians live with diabetes, and almost 30 per cent of people in WA live outside major cities.

Videoconference appointments can be held at the local hospital, health centre, community resource centre and even from home if a person has the right computer or hand-held device and good internet coverage.

People can self-refer to the Diabetes Telehealth Service or be referred by their doctor, nurse or allied health professional.
