Junk, Whitegoods and Metals

√ Whitegoods (fridges, stoves, microwaves etc.)Doors must be removed from fridges and freezers

√ Scrap metal

✓ General junk (furniture and other household items)
✓ Timber products (up to 1.5m long)
✓ Two trailer loads, 6' x 4' or 3m3 - excess waste will not be removed

Green Waste

- √ 1.5m in length
 √ 300mm in diameter
- ✓ Two trailer loads, 6' x 4' or 3m3 excess green waste will not be removed

Shire of Tammin

An Ordinary Postal Election will be held on Saturday, 21 October 2017 in the Shire of Tammin to fill the following vacancies:

Tammin 3 Councillors 4 year term

Nominations Open on Thursday, 7 September 2017

Nominations Close at 4:00pm (sharp) Thursday, 14 September 2017

Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer:

- · at any time during the above period by arrangement; or
- between 2:00pm and 4:00pm Thursday, 14 September 2017 (close of nominations) at the Shire of Tammin, 1 Donnan Street, Tammin.

Nominations Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. (This form is available from the Returning Officer, the Western Australian Electoral Commission or the Shire of Tammin);
- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of information about the candidate;
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, bank cheque or postal order); and
- · a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

What's happening on our local roads??

The budget for the 2017/2018 financial year was adopted at the council meeting held on the 27th July 2017. Despite the scarcity of grant funding and the surprise reduction of road maintenance funds by the State Government, the Shire will progress with a number of capital projects including:

Capital Projects

- Tamma Village Fencing
- Tamma Village Reticulation
- Tammin Multi Purpose Courts
- Plant Trailer for Shire machinery
- Tammin Wyalkatchem Road 2km section, widening upgrade and sealing
- Tammin Wyalkatchem Road 2km final seal
- Bungulla North Road 3km section, pavement repairs, widening upgrade vegetation management and sealing
- Gravel re-sheeting
 - Various unsealed roads within the Shire

There are some other projects that may be included later in the budget, but depending on what the outcome is of the Federal and State Governments funding arrangements, the projects will be decided if and when they may be included once the arrangements are finalised.
