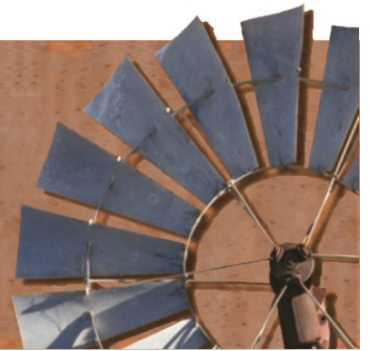

SUBSIDISED Seedlings | Fencing | Pest Control in 2018

DEADLINE EXTENDED

Native seedlings, fencing and assistance for pest control will be offered to eligible landholders wishing to protect and restore existing vegetation, create wildlife corridors to connect fragmented remnants and control invasive pest animals in 2018.

Criteria:

- Your project must connect or expand an area of existing remnant vegetation. Participants to carry out activities in the Shires of Quairading, Cunderdin or Tammin.
- Priority will be given to land managers that can implement all three components of the project: revegetation, fencing and control of pest animals.
- Landholders are responsible for all site preparation, planting, maintenance and the installation of fencing.

*This project is subject to State Government funding through the State NRM Office. Successful landholders will be contacted.
