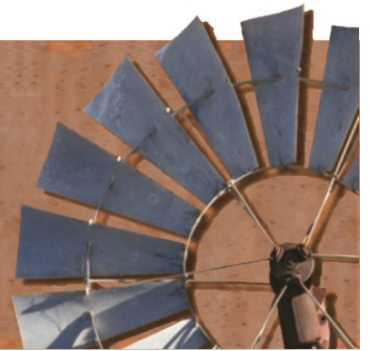
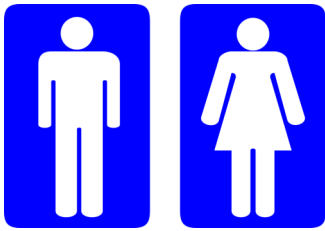

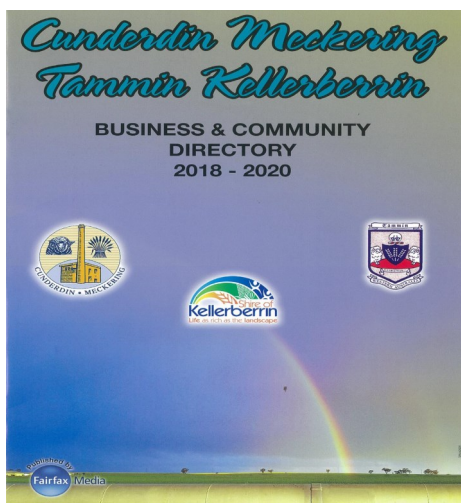

**Responses required by Wednesday 19 December 2018 to ensure the continuation of the project.**

The Shires of Quairading, Cunderdin, and Tammin have funding from the State NRM Office for the protection of native vegetation. If you have an area that you are interested in protecting then we may be able to provide monetary assistance for fencing and/or feral animal management activities.

If you are interested in fencing remnant bushland or receiving seedlings in 2019, please act now. Fill out these few short questions and return to the Shire Offices or to Dylan Copeland at [nrmo@icloud.com](mailto:nrmo@icloud.com) or on 0488 471 727.

Once this completed form has been received you will be contacted to discuss your proposed site in greater detail.

### Criteria:

- Participants to conduct work only on land within the Shires of Quairading, Cunderdin, or Tammin—if you are interested in conducting work in a different Shire please contact me;
- No stock can have access to the revegetation;
- Landholders to be responsible for the erection of fences, and feral animal control, and must be prepared to maintain the site for at least 10 years.

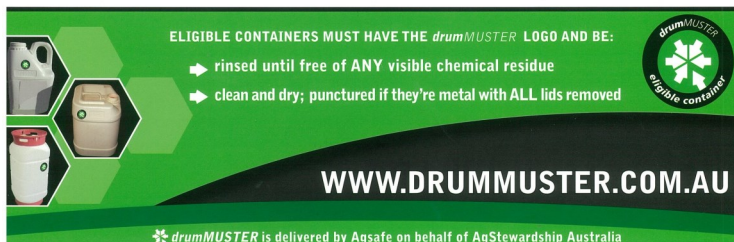

**1st November - 14th February**       **Prohibited**

**Restricted Burning Period**                **Permits**  
**15th February - 15th March**           **Required**

The above dates may change due to seasonal fire conditions in which case the details of the changes will be published in the local press and on Council's website.

## HARVEST VEHICLE MOVEMENT AND HOT WORKS BAN

A harvest vehicle movement ban require the cessation of all harvesting operations within the Shire of Tammin.

A vehicle movement ban does not permit the movement of vehicles on properties except for the essential watering of stock in a diesel powered vehicle.

A hot works ban is defined as a ban on the outdoor use of all welding, grinding and abrasive tools on properties within the Shire.

Harvest vehicle movement and hot works bans will be applied by the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer when weather conditions indicate it necessary.

Bans will be advertised on the Shire of Tammin Website and Facebook. Text messages are also sent via the Shire of Tammin SMS service. Further information is available on the automated Harvest Ban Line on 9637 0309.
