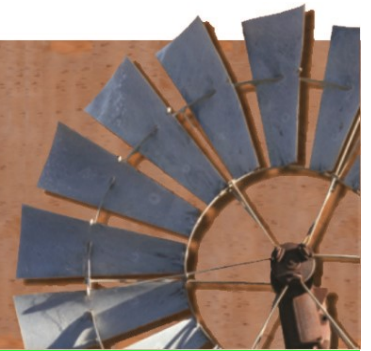

Shire of Tammin President Michael Greenwood has spearheaded many local initiatives that have made a significant improvement to the small community of Tammin, in the State's central wheatbelt. Elected to Council in 2004, Michael became Shire President in 2017, and was the driving force behind the upgrades to the Town Hall and the Pavilion sporting complex. He is actively involved with a recycling business that assists people in need and makes weekly visits to the organisation to help where needed. Michael is a member of the Heath and Planning Committee, the Resources Sharing Committee, the Kellerberrin Regional Road Sub Group and the Tamma Village Joint Allocation Panel Committee.

Serving the community of Tammin on two separate occasions, Donald Thomson was elected to Council from 2001 until 2005, and then again in 2012. He is currently the Shire's Deputy President and has been a driving force behind a number of innovative programs including the CEO Resource Sharing Committee with the Shire of Cunderdin. Donald is a strong advocate for an increase in road funding to the region, and is the Shire's delegate on the Kellerberrin Regional Road Sub Group. He is also the delegate to the East Avon Regional Organisation of Councils and is passionate about securing the long-term sustainability of the Tammin community without exposing the Council to unnecessary risks. Over many years he has been involved with local sporting groups, particularly the Tammin Football Club and the Tammin Bowling Club.

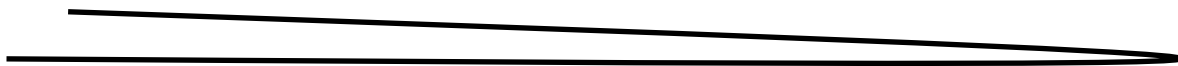




The Sweet Tammin Café has now opened, Bill and Tracey have taken on the transformation of the old Tammin Hotel.

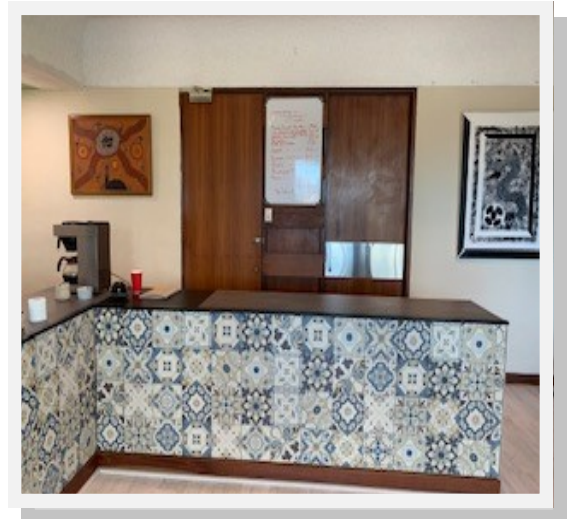
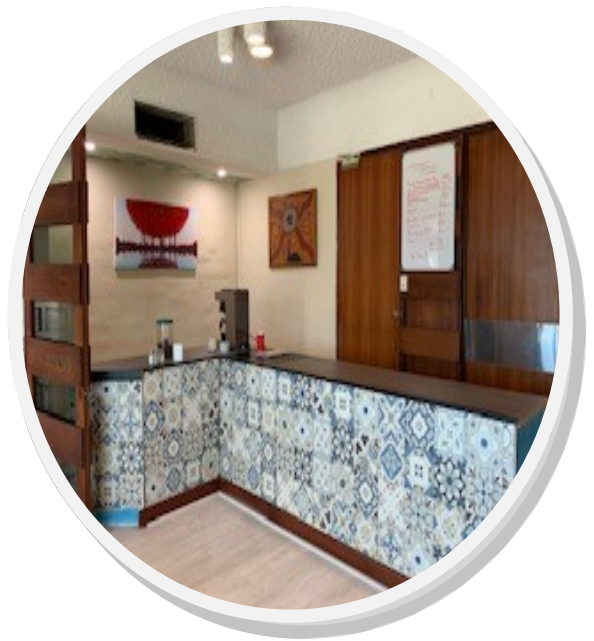

Enrolling to vote

For the Local Government Election on 19 October 2019

My circumstances are:	Do I have to apply to be on the roll?
You live in the district (or ward) and are on the State electoral roll.	No need to apply.
You live in the district (or ward) and are not on the State electoral roll.	Yes—Get a form from any post office or the WA Electoral Commission and get the form back to them by 5:00pm on 30th August 2019.
You are not an Australian Citizen but were on the local government electoral roll in 1996 and have owned or occupied rateable property in the district since then.	Yes—See how to apply below.
Your property is rateable and is owned or occupied by more than two people or by a company.	Two people only who are not already on the local government roll for the district (or ward) must be selected by a majority of the owners or occupiers or the company. They must be on the State or Commonwealth roll to be eligible. If more than one property is involved the same two people must be nominated for all the properties.
You own property that is rateable in the district (or ward) and you are on the State or Commonwealth electoral roll but you live elsewhere.	Yes—See how to apply below.
You have a right of occupancy of property in the district (or ward) that is rateable and you are on the State or Commonwealth electoral roll but live elsewhere	If you have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date you apply you should make an application—See how to apply below.

How to apply

You can get an "Enrolment Eligibility Claim" form from any local government office. To be able to vote for this election your application must reach the person named below by 4:00pm on the 30th August 2019. Those nominated by a company must attach the letter of nomination to the form.

Nominations are called for the following Local Government Elections, to be held on Saturday, 19 October 2019 to fill vacancies on the Councils listed below.

Nomination Time and Place

- Nominations for all vacancies open on Thursday, 5 September 2019
- Nominations must be lodged by 4:00pm, Thursday, 12 September 2019
- Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer at any time during the above period at the offices of the Local Government.

Nomination Requirements

- Candidates are required to lodge with the RETURNING OFFICER:
 - a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Local Government offices listed below.

- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs.
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, or postal order, or bank cheque subject to Returning Officer approval).
- a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).

To nominate, every individual must complete the mandatory online candidate induction module available via the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries website at www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

Full details about eligibility and nomination procedures for prospective candidates in the elections listed below can be obtained by contacting your Local Government office.

Where there are multiple vacancies of varying terms within a single District or Ward, the candidate term of office will be determined by the election.

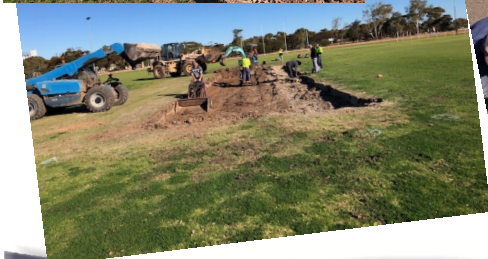
Is every one ready for the cricket season?
