March Works Report

The Shire of Tammin would like to advise that sections of Tammin Wyalkatchem Rd and Tammin South Rd road works are now complete.

The re-sheet work on Wyola Road Nelson Road are also complete. The Shire crew are now working on preparation for road works on Wyola North Road and Chappell-Wheeldon Road, there will also be works to install a new flood way on Chappell-Wheeldon Road.

We would like to thank you for you patience.

As you may have noticed, the corellas seemed to have moved on away from Tammin and have migrated in a Westerly direction, maybe looking for less drier conditions. We will keep monitoring the area should they come back within the Shire of Tammin, appropriate action will take place.

Works and services are still looking for some existing or potential gravel pits, I will be in contact with land owners to identify and excavate some test pits in areas where gravel could be sourced for the maintenance of the road network. This gravel would be used within a radius of 10km of the pit to improve conditions of existing unsealed roads.

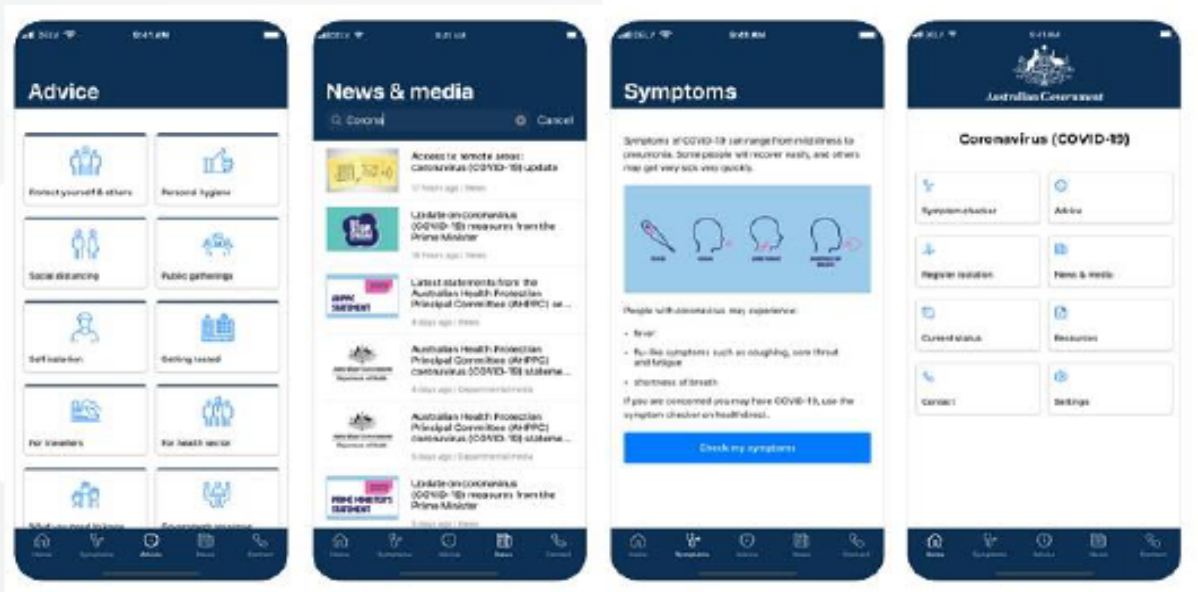

Emergencies and urgent matters will always be attended to as High Priority.

I am pleased to advise that the Kellerberrin/Tammin Local Emergency Management Committee will convene as required to ensure that the Agencies and Volunteers are best supported and that we can best manage the situation locally.

I advise that this Month's Council Meeting held on Thursday 26th March 2020 trialed the use of electronic attendance by some Councillors with a view to holding some future Council meetings on a fully remote e-meeting arrangement so that Council is adhering to the Indoor Gathering Limits ordered by the Federal Government.

In closing, these are indeed unprecedented times and require actions for our small Community, however the emergency we face is at a National and International scale I urge all Community Members to work together, stay calm and look out for the elderly and the vulnerable in our Community and may our community spirit get us through this time.
