Cunderdin Health Centre Update October 2020

As the Covid-19 pandemic continues we are lucky to have no community transmission in WA. We ask people to be patient as we continue to have the main entrance door locked and visitors to the Centre are asked to use the bell and intercom system for health screening prior to entering the building.

The Cunderdin Medical Practice has now relocated to join us at the Health Centre so many people will now be visiting the building for the first time.

A reminder that the Covid-19 Virus is still of concern and social distancing, hand washing and staying home if you have a cold or flu are all very important.

Healthy Eating Activity and Lifestyle (HEAL) Program

This program offers a 2 hour group session each week for 8 weeks during which there is 1 hour of gentle exercise and 1 hour of lifestyle education.

October 2020 Works Report

The Shire of Tammin has completed the shoulder maintenance work of our sealed roads, we are currently starting the preparation work for the reconstruction of some sections of roads such as Bungulla North Rd on a 3km section, Yorkrakine Rd opposite the golf course and Tammin South adding another kilometre to the section completed last year.

Gardens and reserves within town are kept well maintained, thanks to David M. for the good work.

Unfortunately due to the low rainfall this year, our small dam is only at 15% capacity and the second dam is dry, we will try to save water as much as possible for the oval and keep it as green as possible.

Main Roads have finished the drainage work in front of the office. This will help the water run off the road.

New signage is being installed at the new path near the railway station, to warn pedestrians of the heavy vehicle traffic crossing the path. Please proceed with caution when crossing the CBH area to get access to the train station on the Northern side of the railway.


