

## **April & May Works Report**

The Shire of Tammin has finished the work in town on Shields Street and Booth Street. A new asphalt surface has been installed on Booth Street and the Tamma Village has also been resealed. The information Bay on Great Eastern Hwy has also been resealed and kerbed. New footpaths and pram ramps have been installed for safer access for pedestrians. The connection from the Shire office to the Tamma Village, the school and the KEP is now complete and safer for all pedestrians.

A new fence has been installed all the way around the Kadjininy KEP Park and is part of an ongoing plan to revitalise the Park and its surroundings.

New basket-ball and Netball towers will be installed at the Oval in the next couple of weeks.

Extra roadwork on Bungulla North Rd is now complete; totalling a length of 4.5km being reconstructed this financial year.

Gravel resheet program on Turon Rd, Nelson Rd, Wyola South Rd and Youering Rd is now completed. The treatment done on Youering rd is a trial to ensure that the clay content of the road is reduced by adding some smaller stones into the road pavement. This should render the road safer and non-slippery. We will be monitoring the efficiency of the process over the winter months.

Maintenance grading of unsealed roads will resume in the coming weeks and we are currently working on clearing all the culverts and repairing where required within our road network.

We are currently refurbishing the kitchen at the Cooinda Op-Shop and the work should be completed within the next week or so.
