June Works Report

The Shire crew is now working on maintenance works throughout the Shire, maintenance grading in the south part of the Shire, culvert cleaning and repairs in the north part of the Shire. We are taking advantage of the ground moisture to do maintenance grading.

New Speed Display signs have been installed on the Tammin Wyalkatchem Rd and McLaren Rd, as a reminder of the speed limits in town. These signs will also be moved around town and on the Great Eastern Hwy to remind all road users to slow down through our town.

New basketball and Netball towers have been installed at the Oval and repairs have taken place on the playing surface, we hope the community will enjoy the facility and take the opportunity to go out and play.

The kitchen at the Cooinda Op-Shop has been refurbished and is now looking near new and welcoming for all of those who are having morning tea.

On another note, some damage has been done to the "pencil" at the entrance of the Donnan Park, after review of the camera footage it appears that a very large truck may have caused it on the night of the 21st of June. The matter has been reported to the police.
