LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINARY ELECTION CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS Shire of Tammin

ROLL CLOSE: 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government elections on 16 October 2021 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Tammin.

Residents

You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll and meet the eligibility criteria, or if you have changed address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

Enrolment Forms

Electoral enrolment forms are available from the Shire of Tammin, all Australian Electoral Commission offices (www.aec.gov.au) or the Western Australian Electoral Commission (www.elections.wa.gov.au) and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer in Western Australia by 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers

If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Tammin and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote. If you are **not** on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll and own or occupy rateable property in the Shire of Tammin you may be eligible to enrol to vote. This applies if you were on the last electoral roll for the Shire of Tammin prior to May 1996 and have owned or occupied rateable property in the district continuously since this time. Please contact your local government for details. Owners of land who were on the last Local Government roll continue to retain that status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact the Shire of Tammin to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date of the application to enrol.

Joint Owners and Occupiers

If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Corporations

A body corporate that owns or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Enrolment Forms - Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Only

Enrolment forms can be obtained from local governments and must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021. Further information can be obtained from the Shire of Tammin.

NOMINATIONS FOR SHIRE ELECTIONS BE A VOCAL LOCAL STAND FOR COUNCIL



Yesterday, 9th August 2021, was the 73rd Anniversary of the 1st MEETING of the Tammin Road Board - Now Shire of Tammin.

If you want to be involved in the future of your community, and are willing to learn and participate, then you should explore what it takes to be a councillor and nominate for local government elections.

Between the 2nd September and 9th September nominations will be open. The Shire of Tammin Council will have 3 positions vacant as not all current sitting members are intending to re-nominate for council. These positions are required to be filled in order to have the required quorum of four members to operate. The failure to meet the quorum requirements will have adverse impacts on the future of the Shire.

For the first time it is necessary for anyone nominating to complete a free online induction course provided by the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries (DLGSC). This course gives community members a basic understanding of what is required from a council member.

CALL 000 TO REPORT A FIRE!

BUSHFIRES ACT

FUEL REDUCTION AND FIRE-BREAK REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, you are hereby

required on or before the 1st day of November 2021 to construct fire breaks and/or clear your property of flammable material in accordance with the following, and thereafter to maintain fire breaks up to and including the 1st day of April 2022.

Townsite:

Land Area less than 2048m2

All hazardous material is to be removed from the whole of the land except living trees, shrubs and plants. The remaining vegetation is to be maintained to a height of no greater than 7.5cm.

Townsite:

Land Area greater than 2048m2

All land over 2048m² is to comply with the requirements of rural land

This is to be maintained for the duration of the restricted and prohibited burning periods.

Tammin Rural Land

All land is required to have a bare mineral earth fire break not less than 3 meters in width immediately inside all external boundaries of said land.

All land surrounding erected buildings is required to be cleared of all flammable material by way of burning, slashing or mowing, and maintained to a height not greater than 75mm.
