Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act

On the 19th of June the Shire's Chief Executive Officer and a number of Councillors attended the information session on the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act held in Merredin. It is our understanding from the session that the Act only applies to areas that are registered Aboriginal Cultural Heritage sites, however the mapping tool that shows these sites, the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Inquiry System (ACHIS), was not available until the 1st of July 2023. The Shire of Tammin did a search of the ACHIS on the 3rd of July and only one site is registered within the Shire of Tammin Local Government boundary.

Advice received at the information session was that property owners are encouraged to do a search of their properties on the ACHIS and keep a record of this on file to demonstrate that due diligence has been completed and if there is no registered site on your property then no further action is required from you in relation to the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act.
