


Budget Adoption

At its July Ordinary Council Meeting the Council adopted the 23/24 Annual Budget. The Budget for the upcoming year includes some very exciting and important projects.

Our capital road jobs for the coming year a section of road widening and resealing on Bungulla North Road, a second coat seal on a section of Yorkrakine Rd along with some floodway works on Cubbine and Yorkrakine Road. Council budget each year four kilometres for gravel resheating. The Shire have a list of our important distributor gravel roads that need attention however the exact section of this list that will be undertaken this year will depend on where we can get access to gravel. We would love to hear from anyone that has gravel available for the Shire to purchase.

Some of the other notable project from the budget include:

- Retiling and plumbing works to the Female public toilets at the Pavilion
- Replace doors at the Pavilion
- Installation of guttering and water tank at the golf club
- More lighting at the Oval
- New visitor information bay
- Numerous plant purchases to maintain our fleet
- Industrial dishwasher at the town hall

Ever been rostered on to run the gate at Donnan Park and had the pleasure of darting out from your car in the freezing rain as people arrived?

Say goodbye to soggy shivering shifts and hello to the new gate booth at the entry of Donnan Park! Equipped with access windows on the side for serving the spectators as they arrive and a viewing window out the front so that you don't miss any of the action!

This project was identified as a priority by the sporting clubs that regularly utilise the oval at the stakeholder engagement night we held earlier in the year.

OUTSIDE WORKS

- The Tammin Dog Rest Area is now complete! YAY. The outside crew works hard to get all of the grass and signs installed and tree planted.
- 4,500 trees have recently been planted in the road reserve on the new Southern Link Bypass and the old Hunts Road reserve.
- A new fence and bollards have been installed at the back of the Donnan Park Pavilion to protect the septic pump from further damage.
- Maintenance grading has been undertaken on the following local roads:
 - 11 Mile Road
 - York Road
 - Hocking Road
 - Lowes Road
 - Waltham Road
 - Yorkrakine Road
 - Nock Road
 - Section of Bungulla North Road
 - Gold Links Road
 - Packham Road
 - Parrawilla Road
 - Wyola South Road
 - Franklin Road
- Heavy maintenance work has been completed on Wyola North Road with additional gravel coverage.
- The town crew have been working hard to keep drains cleaned and the streets tidy. They have also slashed road reserves along the highway, creating a neat entrance into the Tammin townsite.
- A new 24 hour defibrillator has recently been installed at Donnan Park, next to the public BBQ facility at the Pavilion.
