Council has resolved that the Tammin Alcoa Landcare Education Centre cease operations at the end of the 2008 calendar year. The decision is the culmination of an extensive consultation process over nearly 2 years which included workshops, community surveys and discussions at the General Electors meeting.

### **Cunderdin Tammin Landcare Conservation District**


The Committee which organised this operation was formally wound up in December 2007. Following the publication of the book *Shifting Culture – The Branching Out Big Time Project* (copies of which are available from the Shire Office) the Committee's surplus funds were disbursed between the Shire of Cunderdin and the Shire of Tammin. Council has resolved that Tammin' share (\$8,562.36) be utilised in the replacing of the southern fence at Kadjininy Kep – a project which recognises some of the landcare achievements of the district.

## **Yorkrakine Centenary Celebrations**

Council has resolved to support the Celebrations, to be held on 11 October 2008, both financially and granting the use of the landcare or community bus and to allow the temporary closure of the section of Bungulla North Rd adjacent to the Hall.
